The New to You Sale is one of two major fundraisers that support the programming and charitable projects the women of the Junior League do across the community. With a focus on issues, activities and education to prepare families and children for elementary school, JLFW and its members provide financial and volunteer support to area nonprofit organizations offering early childhood development services.

JLFW members will spend the week leading up to the sale collecting donated items and arranging the sale floor while sharing the mission of the JLFW with all community members.
